

Conversion to Deltek Costpoint v7.0.1

As we upgrade to Costpoint 7, please note the differences to how we gain access to Costpoint and Impromptu. Beyond the look and feel, access to Costpoint will only be available using the following web link: <https://cpweb.jlab.org>, which will also be on your Insight page.

Once you have accessed the login page for Costpoint 7, please note you must use your **JLab CUE Password** to access the system, not the password you have used to access Costpoint in the past. In the field underneath the password, please select the Database or System you are using (e.g. JSA).





Accessing Impromptu will continue as before using your Oracle password, which is the **same password you used to access Costpoint 6.2 (e.g. the old version)**.
