

EXPLORERS *wanted!*

Jefferson Lab is offering a Research Assistantship for a minority or female undergraduate student from an accredited university. The assistantship would offer the student an opportunity to work on science and engineering projects related to the lab's research. Jefferson Science Associates will provide funds to support the student at the university during the 2016 - 2017 academic year. This project is supported by the JSA Initiatives Fund Program, a commitment from the JSA owners, SURA and PAE Applied Technologies. Initiatives Funds support programs, initiatives, and activities that further the scientific outreach, promote the science, education and technology of Jefferson Lab and benefit the lab's extended user community in ways that complement the lab's basic and applied research missions.

- **Students must be enrolled full-time as a junior or senior during the 2016 -2017 academic year to be eligible.**
- **Students must be nominated by a faculty member in order to apply for the assistantship.**
- **JSA will provide a \$5,000 stipend to the selected student's university to pay the student through its student employment program. The assistantship will not provide support for tuition, fees and other such expenses.**
- **The selected student will work at the university under the guidance of a university faculty member.**
- **The selected student must submit a project report at the end of the assistantship.**
- **Additionally, up to \$1,500 is available for the selected student to visit Jefferson Lab or to attend a related research workshop.**
