The successful candidate will be expected to teach courses and labs in lower and upper levels of Physics. The position requires participation in department and university outcomes assessment, participate in department service and university activities, and perform other assignments as per departmental needs. The successful candidate will engage in reasonable research/scholarship for their field and the university. Research that can engage NMU undergraduate students is preferred but not required. This is a campus-based position.

**Required Education:**

Doctorate of Physics or equivalent terminal degree earned by June 30, 2019

**Required knowledge, skills, abilities or attributes:**

- Teaching and instruction for groups of individuals
- Ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing with peers and students
- Ability to work effectively and productively with others
- Ability to produce appropriate physics-related scholarship
- Time management skills
- Ability to work with minimal supervision

- Previous teaching experience at the undergraduate level for both majors in physics (lower and upper level courses), and non-majors (algebra based intro courses)
- Ability and desire to teach astronomy courses (lecture and lab)
