Undergraduate Research Assistantship

Jefferson Lab is offering a Research Assistantship for two minority or female undergraduate students from an accredited university. This assistantship offers the students an opportunity to work on science and engineering projects related to the lab's research. Jefferson Science Associates will provide funds to support the students at the university during the **2020 - 2021** academic year.

- Students must be enrolled full-time during the 2020 - 2021 academic year to be eligible.
- Students must be a physics major.
- Students must be nominated by a faculty member in order to apply for the assistantship.
- JSA will provide a \$6,000 stipend to the selected student's university to pay the student through its student employment program. The assistantship will not provide support for tuition, fees, support of senior thesis projects or other such expenses.
- The selected student will work at the university under the guidance of a university faculty member.
- The selected students must submit a project report at the end of the assistantship.
- Additionally, up to \$1,500 is available for the selected students to visit Jefferson Lab or to attend a related research workshop.
